It is also a great way just to get him brushed up on his obedience or to have some special problems worked on. Summer Tune Up Classes

These classes provide an opportunity to work your dog amid a variety of distractions. The structure of the class is much the same as our Off Lead class in that the dogs are all worked together at the same time. The goal in this class is to work through various behavior problems. Leash aggression and dog socialization skills are the main focus. It is a fun class and a bargain at \$5.00 per dog, drop in charge. Classes are on Monday evenings at 6:30 PM and Saturdays at 1:30 PM. Come on out for it. You'll be thrilled with the results in your dog.

Canine First Aid Class

The First Aid classes will be offered again this fall. The date is September 21 and September 28 at 6:30 PM. This is a good opportunity for you to gain valuable information and life saving techniques for your pet. It is a two part class. Week one is basic health and maintenance and week two is Emergency care . The cost is very reasonably priced at \$35.00 for both 2 hr. classes.
